In Thailand, Songkran is the country's most famous festival. An important and ancient event on the Buddhist calendar, Thailand's infamous water festival lasts for 3 days and marks the beginning of the traditional Thai New Year.



The name Songkran comes from a Sanskrit word meaning 'passing' or 'approaching', and the occasion is rich in symbolic traditions.



The mornings usually begin with merit-making, often by visiting a local temple. Also known as the Water Festival, Songkran entails pouring water on Buddha statues and senior monks, as well as the young and elderly, in a traditional ritual. This represents good luck, purification and the washing away of one's sins.
